Special Regulations:

- a. All entries must have the **name and age** (individual work) or **school and class** (group work) clearly marked on the **back** of the entry.
- b. Individual entries can be mounted on cardboard but should not be framed.
- c. ***Group work maximum size is 2 metres x 1.5 metres and should be 2 dimensional. Any work greater than this size will not be judged and, depending on space, may not be hung.***
- d. All group work to be prepared on a medium suitable for hanging eg: strong cardboard. To protect entries **strong masking tape and strong glue** must be used in its construction.
- e. **For group work, the school class name and a brief description of the work must be included on the entry form.**
